Audiom can be inserted alongside an existing visual map to only provide non-visual access, or completely replace existing map viewers.

**Evaluation Methods Used:** Evaluation of the product involved a combination of manual and functional testing against the applicable success criteria within the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.1 Conformance Level A, AA, and AAA. Level Access (Level) tested a selection of the product using a representative sample to cover the components and functionality of use flows.
